PSY 200 Understanding the Old Testament 3hrs

Developing beliefs and practice of Hebrew religion on as set forth in the Old Testament. Meaning of its forth for the modern world.

PSY 205 Introduction to the New Testament 3hrs

Exploration of the New Testament as a living document that has shaped Christian life in the past and continues to do so today.

PSY 210 Introduction to Psychology 3hrs

An introduction to all the major areas of psychology. An explanation of the subject of psychology with the emphasis on human experiences and behavior.

PSY 212 Personality 3hrs

Principles of development and maintenance of a healthy, functioning personality and the theorists and their supporting evidence.

PSY 214 Human and Growth Development 3hrs

Development of the individual from birth through life stages. The emotional, social, intellectual, and motor spheres, will provide understanding of origins and growth of personality.

PSY 216 Introduction to Counseling 3hrs

An introductory course which surveys the major concepts and practices of contemporary counseling systems and focuses on ethical, professional, and personal issues in counseling practices.

PSY 218 Abnormal Psychology 3hrs

This course studies the behavior disorder; covers the entire range of abnormal behavior and explanation, insight and action.

PSY 220 Conditioning and Learning 3hrs

Models and theories of classical and operant conditioning. It focuses on contemporary research and applications of associative and instrumental learning.

PSY 222 Psychology of the Exceptional Child 3hrs

The students will study the psychological concepts of children's problems-mental, social, emotional, and psychological.

PSY 224 Experimental Psychology 3hrs

This course is an introduction to and an overview of the basic principles of experimentation and psychological research. Development of an applied research study is the cornerstone of the course.

PSY 226 Group Counseling 3hrs

Study of group dynamics and theory, including participation in group experiences, stimulations and role-playing.

PSY 228 Theology of Death and Dying 3hrs

A study of death and dying from the viewpoint of Christian theology and ethics taking into account also what other religions and the biological psychological and social sciences have had to say on the subject. Special emphasis on medical ethics brought on by modern medical technology.
